Our second meeting to discuss ways to help spread the word about Our Saviour.

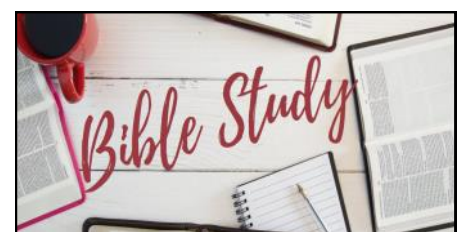
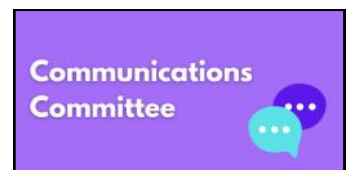
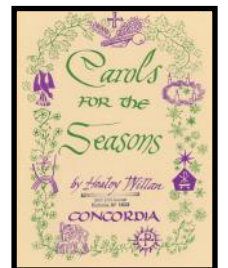

Jubilees Christmas Luncheon

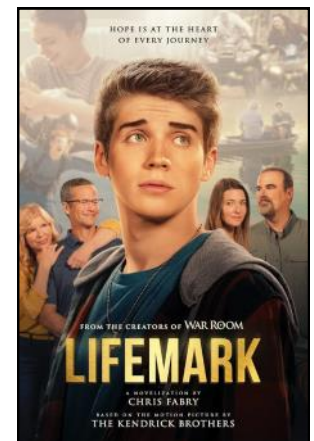
