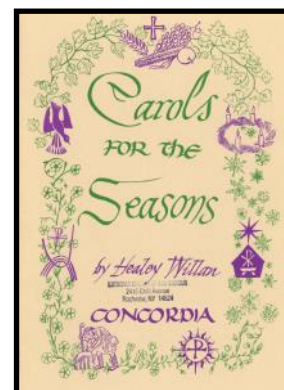
### The Angel Tree

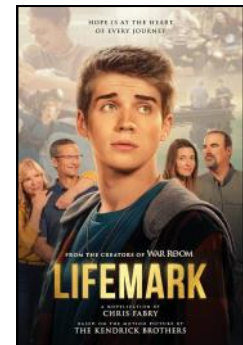
### Jubilees Christmas Luncheon
