# GOD'S GREAT MERCY

a stewardship program for our congregation

Our congregation is a gathering of, "therefore," people. We have experienced God's great mercy. "Therefore," we work together to proclaim that mercy in the world through both word and deed. So that we can do even more of God's work, you are encouraged to increase your giving by 1/2 of 1% of your household income. This amount should be added to whatever amount you gave last year.

#### Below is a formula to help you:

#### Let's say your household income is \$50,000 per year. And you pledged \$5000 for this past year.

To figure out what to add to that this coming year, follow this formula:

yearly household income x .005 = what you need to add to your upcoming year pledge \$50,000 x .005 = \$250 So you would pledge \$5,250 for 2025.

We ask you to prayerfully consider this increase.

In the mail this coming week you will receive a letter and ways to indicate your giving for the coming year. Please look for the letter and either bring your response to worship next week, or mail your response to the church.
